## MORNING DROPOFF & AFTERNOON PICKUP

3K, 4K, and 5K parents are required to park and come into the building to sign-in/out a student in Procure for morning drop-off/afternoon pick-up. When dropping off 1st-8th grade students in the morning or picking them up in the afternoon, parents should pull up along the sidewalk near the new school entrance underneath the overhang. If a 1-8 parent would like to come into the building with their student, he/she should accompany him/her in the parking lot. No student is permitted to cross the parking lot without being accompanied by an adult. Students may be dropped off between 7:40 - 7:55 am. Our school day begins at 8:00 am. Please do not drop your student off before 7:40 am. Our faculty begins each day with a devotion and a short business meeting. It is best to have the entire faculty present. Also, please have your student picked up no later than 3:45 pm. Thanks for your understanding with these requests.

## AFTER SCHOOL CARE

- ◆ After school care is offered from the conclusion of each school day until 5:30 pm. The program is available for all 1-8 students for daily or occasional use. After school care takes place in the school commons. Students should plan to work on something quietly during this time.
- ◆ Parents are required to sign their student out of after care when they pick their student up. The cost to make use of the program is \$2.50 per half-hour or any part thereof. Parents should be sure to pick up their child by 5:30pm. Billing will be accomplished through our billing program (TADS).
- ◆ At this point in time, we are still looking for first through eighth grade after-school care help for the 2023-2024 school year. Hours are Monday through Friday from 3:30-5:30 pm. Please contact Mr. Wieting if you are interested or would like more information. Job sharing is a possibility if you prefer not to commit to five days.

## CHAPEL INVITATION JOIN US

- ◆ St. Paul's student body gathers each morning Monday through Thursday for chapel. Parents are invited to attend any and all chapel services they would like. We love having guests for worship! Chapel begins each morning at 8:05 am. Our chapel offerings for the first semester will go to the WELS Committee on Relief.

## HOT LUNCH INFO!

- ◆ Hot lunch is provided every day for students that are interested. Meals are prepared and served by certified staff. Current K-8 fees are \$3.50 for a lunch (includes milk). 3K students pay \$2.75 per lunch, and 4K students pay \$3.00. A milk only option is available for \$.50. Microwaves are available for cold lunch students who still desire a warm meal.
- ◆ As a convenience, lunch fees will be billed through our Procure/Tuition Express (3K, 4K, 5K) or TADS (1-8). Parents will receive an email notification of their total bill and when payments will be taken out of their account. Parents should contact the school office with any billing questions.
- ◆ This year, we would like to help Mrs. Wall by taking a rough count of those taking hot lunch for the month. Please click on the link below to sign-up for the month of August.

## TADS INFORMATION

All tuition and billing is handled through your TADS account. Billing is done on the 5th and 20th of each month. Tuition is included in the billing on the 5th of the month, unless other arrangements have been made.

There is a 0.3% charge for every ACH transaction. This charge has a minimum limit of \$3.00 and a maximum limit of \$7.00 This will apply to all ACH transactions throughout the school year. TADS adds a \$50 charge for late payments or returned payments.

## EDUCATE INFORMATION

The other part of the TADS information system is called Educate. Parents in grades 1 - 8 can make use of this website to track a student's educational progress. (There is a separate website and login for this.) You can see your student's current grades as the teachers add daily assignments throughout the quarter.
