After school care is offered from the conclusion of each school day until 5:30 pm. The program is available for all 1-8 students for daily or occasional use. After school care takes place in the school commons. Students should plan to work on something quietly during this time. Parents are required to sign their student out of after care when they pick their student up. The cost to make use of the program is \$2.50 per half-hour or any part thereof. Parents should be sure to pick up their child by 5:30 pm. Billing will be accomplished through our billing program (TADS).

At this point in time, we are still looking for first through eighth grade after-school care help for the 2023-2024 school year. Hours are Monday through Friday from 3:30-5:30 pm. Please contact Mr. Wieting if you are interested or would like more information. Job sharing is a possibility if you prefer not to commit to five days. Please strongly consider this opportunity for as of right now, Mr. Wieting is covering this commitment to the parents of St. Paul's.







St. Paul's utilizes MAP Growth testing for assessing students and planning instruction. The strength of this program is formative design as well as the ability to track student growth over time. Grades 3-8 are tested in Reading, Math, and Language. Our first testing window is the week of September 18-22. If you would like to learn more about MAP Growth, you may visit their website or contact your student's classroom teacher.

St. Paul's Lutheran School holds school safety drills each year according to state law. We will be conducting a Low Priority Lockdown Drill on Monday, September 11. An Active Threat Drill will be conducted on Wednesday, September 27. Students will be informed of the purpose of these drills in age-appropriate ways. Current K-8 fees are \$3.50 for a lunch (includes milk). 3K students pay \$2.75 per ♦ lunch, and 4K students pay \$3.00. A milk only option is available for \$.50. As a convenience, lunch fees will be billed through our Procare/Tuition Express (3K, 4K, 5K) or TADS (1-8). Parents will receive an email notification of their total bill and when payments will be taken

TADS INFORMATION

All tuition and billing is handled through your TADS account. Billing is done on the 5th and 20th of each month. Tuition is included in the billing on the 5th of the month, unless other arrangements have been made.

There is a 0.3% charge for every ACH transaction. This charge has a minimum limit of \$3.00 and a maximum limit of \$7.00 This will apply to all ACH transactions throughout the school year. TADS adds a \$50 charge for late payments or returned payments.

If you have any questions regarding your billing statements, please contact the school office.

EDUCATE INFORMATION

The other part of the TADS information system is called Educate. Parents in grades 1 - 8 can make use of this website to track a student's educational progress. (There is a separate website and login for this.) You can see your student's current grades as the teachers add daily assignments throughout the quarter. Parents have the ability to change settings so communications are only sent to preferred contact info (e.g. only text or email).
