Online Zoom Sunday Bible class beginning in June will be from 9:20-10:00. The topic will be "Sanctification".

We will follow Sheboygan County's capacity and distancing guidelines for worship. Currently our sanctuary can hold 80 people. At phase two (likely soon), that number will increase.

Sign up for the services via the online links above or by calling our office at 920-565-3780. If you want to come to worship but capacity and scheduling prohibit that, please contact us. We can work together to find a solution. We thank everyone for their patience as we navigate these difficult times. We plan to utilize unclaimed seats or the narthex as needed for overflow seating so that we can accommodate visitors and walk-ins. Our worship services will still be available online as well as on Tuesday morning cable TV station WSCS at 10:00 am.

Before each worship service, we will sanitize door handles and pew backs. In the narthex, we will have hand sanitizer stations, boxes for depositing offerings, and a table for purchasing scrip. Bathrooms will be available. Ushers will assist you by opening the doors and guiding you toward your seat. The school wing of the building will be closed off on Sundays. We will have the entire service and songs printed in the bulletin, which will not be returned. You may either take home or discard your bulletin after worship.

Please practice social distancing with people outside your family or group. If you want to gather for extended conversation, please do so outside.

Communion resumes in worship June 14-15. More information will be coming on how that will work. For those who are not yet ready to come back to in-person worship, we will continue to have communion hours 1 day during each week. Please refer to the weekly congregational announcements for the times and which pastor to schedule with.
