TAX INFORMATIC

Tax season is quickly approaching and a simple form can help your family deduct up to \$4,000 for K-8 tuition and \$10,000 for 9-12 tuition on state income taxes. The Wisconsin Department of Revenue has released the 2022 Schedule PS Private School tuition tax deduction form. You will need St. Paul's Federal Employer Identification Number (FEIN) for claiming a deduction for St. Paul's tuition. St. Paul's FEIN: 39-1204930.
