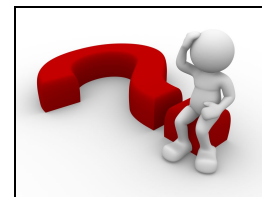

ENROLLMENT

St. Paul's will again be utilizing the student information system "TADS" for enrollment, tuition management/collection and billing. Returning families should have recently received an email from TADS recently to re-enroll.

New families will need to apply as their first step. Begin the application process [HERE](#). You will likely need to create a TADS account.

TUITION AGREEMENTS

Families will have three options to choose from when setting up their tuition agreements.

- 1) Pay tuition in full before the school year.
- 2) Pay tuition in two installments (September and January)
- 3) Pay tuition in nine monthly installments (September through May)

**Families who choose option 3 will be charged a \$55 administrative fee from TADS. All tuition payments come out on the 5th of the month.

Classroom Orientations are intended as an opportunity for parents and teachers to get together and discuss the upcoming school year. Teachers will share classroom information, routines, procedures, and expectations. It is also a time for parents to ask questions and visit their child's classroom.
