


St. Paul's Lutheran Sunday School Handbook

General Information

- Sunday School classes are held on a weekly basis beginning on September 11, 2022 and end after May 21, 2023. Classes will not be held on December 25, January 1, or April 9.
- Classes run from 9:15 to 10:15 am. Parents, please sign your children in and out if they are in the PreK / Kindergarten class or childcare room.
- We have five levels for Sunday School learning:
 - Pre K/K (potty-trained age 3 and above)
 - Grades 1 & 2 Grades 3 & 4
 - Grades 5 & 6 Grades 7 & 8
- Sunday School children will be singing in the following worship services:
 - Sunday, **November 6**, 8:00 and 10:30 am
 - Sunday, **December 18**, 8:00 and 10:30 am for Christmas at St. Paul's (PreK & K only 10:30)
 - Christmas rehearsals Dec. 11 during Sunday School and Dec. 10 & 17 from 9:00-10:30 am
 - Sunday, **April 2**, 8:00 and 10:30 am
 - Thursday, **May 18**, 6:30 pm Ascension
- One Sunday each month Sunday School will begin with the Kids Connection in the 5th-6th grade room.
- Other Sundays will start with some all-grade music practice, usually in the 5th-6th grade room. Students will practice songs for worship services as well as some other fun Bible songs!

Teacher Responsibilities

All our teachers are volunteers. They give their time and skills to instruct the congregation's children in God's word. They promise the following to each of our families:

- To be prepared for their lessons each week. This includes the study of the teacher's guides and thought about the lesson's presentation.
- To care for each of their students and pray for them.
- To do all they can to help the children grow in their knowledge of God's word and in their desire to serve Jesus.
- To strive to make the lesson presentation interesting.

Parent Responsibilities

- Register your children prior to the start of Sunday School.
- Bring your children to Sunday School regularly.
- Have your children at Sunday School ready to start at 9:15 am. (Sign Pre K / K students in and out.)
- Pray for the teachers in their service to Jesus and to your family.

- Come to the adult Bible class during the same time as Sunday School so that you also are growing in your faith.

Child Responsibilities

- Always come with a mind willing to learn and a faith willing to grow.
- Respect and obey your teachers. They are representing the Lord as they teach you his Word.
- Gladly study your lesson each week and learn any assigned memory work.
- Love all those in your class and treat them according to the commandments.

For an Appropriate Learning Experience

- The Sunday School classroom is intended to be a safe and enjoyable place to learn God's Word.
- When a child becomes disruptive, it harms the learning experience for the rest of the students.
- Our volunteer teachers are not asked to carry out disciplinary actions.
- The parents of the disruptive child will be notified immediately to come to the classroom.
- The parents will talk with the disruptive child away from the classrooms.
- When the child is compliant, he or she may return to the classroom to continue learning God's Word.

Offerings

- Each child will receive a set of offering envelopes near the beginning of the year with guidelines on regular giving to our Lord.
